

From the Sheep Yards

Top lambs drop back under \$200 – but only just.

Overall numbers were down this week with sheep numbers less than half of the previous yarding and lambs dropped back under \$200 for the first time since 15th May.



Lambs

Older lambs topped at \$199 (\$202) for lambs (pictured left) sold by DCM on account Bowler brothers, Wheatacres Partnership.

Other good sales included: \$188 for lambs sold by Dennis Wall through Pitt; \$175 for Fitzpatrick, Willow Tree selling through IML; shorn lambs sold by G&C on account Maclure made \$170; big weighty Dorper lambs out of Narrabri sold by DCM made \$155; and the best hoggets made \$155 for Maclure selling through G&C.

Lamb wrap

Lambs sold to \$199 (\$202) and averaged \$130 (\$130); and hoggets sold to \$155 (\$160) and averaged \$140 (\$116).

Sheep

Highlights included: wethers sold by DCM for \$186; big weighty ewes sold by LMK for \$173; and Merino ewes sold by DCM made \$141.

Sheep wrap

Ewes sold to \$173 (\$160) and averaged \$99 (\$99); and wethers sold to \$186 (\$155) and averaged \$138 (\$116).
