



From the sheep yards

Lamb numbers doubled this week and there was a small reduction in the sheep with 2769 lambs and 608 sheep for a total yarding of 3377 head.

LAMBS

For the third week running top price in the lambs was \$170. Top price this week went to BJ & MJ Walters selling through DCM (pictured top left).



Other highlights in the lambs included the first pens of the sale (pictured 2nd from top) sold by PPA on account Forest for \$167.50. Shorn lambs topped at \$162 for lambs sold by RWGC on account Scott Reed while suckers sold to \$55.

Lambs averaged \$130, shorn lambs averaged \$119.

SHEEP

Ewes sold to \$131 for 25 head (pictured 3rd from top) sold by DCM on account W Press. Wethers sold to \$107 with top price going to Farrer Memorial Agricultural High School. Hoggets sold to \$106.00 (average \$88); and rams to \$121 (average \$58).
