Other highlights included suckers sold by B&S on account Robert Carey for \$160. 690 suckers averaged \$141 and 2842 lambs were sold for an average price of \$110.50 Hoggets sold to \$120 and averaged \$104.

SHEEP

Young ewes sold to \$132 for 1st x ewe lambs sold by LMK. Ewes sold to \$120 and averaged \$91 with 448 sold and top price going to Pat and Renee Murphy. Wethers sold to \$118 and averaged \$81 with 609 sold. Top price also went to Beaconsfield Partnership. Rams sold to \$90 for 18 Merino rams sold by Pitt Sons on account DH & AC Lisle, Walcha for \$90. 68 rams were sold for an average price of \$70.50. Mixed sheep sold to \$115.
