Numbers rose this week with a total yarding of 5412.

#### LAMBS

John Roworth, pictured left with selling agent Daniel McCulloch, says that his 89 year old father was "tickled pink" with their lambs this morning and he has every right to be after they well and truly topped the lambs at TR LX today, selling through DCM for \$185. Daniel McCulloch described them as some of the best lambs he has ever seen and, at an average weight of 75kg, James Armitage from the NLRS described them as "some of the heaviest lambs presented at this centre in a very long time." Lambs averaged \$120.50 with 4069 sold.

Top price in the shorn lambs was \$142 for lambs sold by RWGC on account Les and Gwen Coddington, Gunnedah. Shorn lambs averaged \$128.50 with 116 sold.
