LAMBS

3400 lambs sold with suckers selling to \$144 for pen 075 (pictured top left) sold by IML on account MK & D Fitzpatrick, Willow Tree. The average price for suckers was \$129.

Older lambs sold to \$140 for 40 head sold by Mrs T Sutton through CP. Other vendors to make \$140 for their lambs included Fauchon (RWGC) and Bob and Joe Cameron (DCM). The average price for lambs was \$99.



The top Dorper lambs made \$140 for pen 221 (pictured middle left) sold by PPA on account David Small, Cressbrook, Wee Waa. David's father, Tom, was on hand at the sale and said that it was a great result given they were on feed for their first 2-3 months but have had no rain and have been living on saltbush since.

Wethers sold to \$88 and averaged \$64 with 142 sold; ewes sold to \$94 for 121 crossbred ewes, NSM (pictured bottom left) sold by PSPF on account Daniel Kermode and averaged \$80 with 302 sold; and rams sold to \$44 and averaged \$40 with 9 sold.
