

From the sheep yards



Numbers were up by about 600 on last week with a total of 4023 sold including 2446 lambs and 1557 sheep.

LAMBS

Lambs sold to \$151 for the first pen of the day (pictured top left) sold by PPA on account Goran Kelly. Young lambs sold to \$140 with top price going to Tarakan. The top pen of Dorper lambs (pictured bottom left) made \$150 and was sold by G&C on account S & K Keys.



Other highlights included the Hombsch lambs (pictured middle left) sold by DCM for \$147 and a run of 160 2nd x shorn lambs sold by PPA made \$146.

Young lambs averaged \$125.50 and older lambs averaged \$114.



SHEEP

Wethers sold to \$107 and averaged \$77 with 459 sold; ewes sold to \$125 and averaged \$89 with 957 sold; rams sold to \$95 and averaged \$73 with 134 sold.
