Numbers were up this week with a total yarding of 5375 including 3400 lambs and the balance sheep.

LAMBS

Lambs sold to \$170 for 60-72 kg lambs (pictured top left) sold by Elders on account Weroona Partnership, Tamworth.

Other highlights included an outstanding pen of Dorper lambs (pictured 2nd from top) sold by CP on account Dave Robson for \$162.

Shorn lambs sold to \$156 for 20 head sold by Les and Gwen Coddington, Gunnedah. RWGC also sold the first suckers for the season on account John McQueen, Loomberah. They made \$140.



SHEEP

Wethers sold to \$145 with 646 sold for an average price of \$95. Highlights including a run of wethers (pictured bottom left) sold by B&S on account Owen Ryan, Uralla for \$110.

Rams sold to \$100 and averaged \$81 with 80 sold. Ewes sold to \$118 and averaged \$77 with 727 sold.
