



From the sheep yards

A total yarding just under 5500 after a break for the Australia Day Long Weekend.

Lambs

Top price in the lambs was \$155 for lambs sold by RWGC on account Fauchon Pastoral Co (pen 033 pictured top left) and a second pen of 14 sold on account McQueen for the same price. Other highlights included 56 2nd x lambs (pen 67 pictured 2nd from top) sold by Chris Paterson on account Wahnica Partnership, Loomberah for \$154.



3020 lambs were sold at an average price of \$117/head. Shorn lambs topped at \$155 and averaged \$125 for 439 head sold.

Suckers/young lambs

Top price of \$148 went to I & L Rennie. The average was \$130/head with 339 sold.

Ewes

Young ewes sold to \$133 for 86 crossbred ewes (pen 190 pictured bottom left) sold by Landmark Tamworth on consignment from Landmark, Walcha. Average for ewes was \$79/head with 1073 sold.



Wethers

Wethers sold to \$94.50 for 255 head sold on account Spring Valley Wool Co (average \$90.50), hoggets sold to \$98 (average \$58), rams to \$70 (average \$35) and mixed sheep to \$100 (average \$56).
