A total yarding of 5839 head at TRLX this week including 4480 lambs and the balance sheep.

#### LAMBS

Lambs sold to a top of \$180. Highlights included 66+ kg lambs (pen 092 pictured top left) sold by Davidson Cameron McCulloch (DCM) on account Mike Smith for \$170. Other highlights included crossbred lambs sold by B&S on account Robert Carey for \$160; Matapouri made \$165.50 for their lambs sold through Landmark; and 1<sup>st</sup> x ewe lambs (pictured 2<sup>nd</sup> from top) sold by B&S on account Ian and Lorraine Rennie made \$156.



Young lambs sold to \$148 for 40 suckers sold by DCM on account Bowler Brothers. Other highlights included suckers (pictured 3<sup>rd</sup> from top) sold by RWGC on for Fauchon Pastoral Co for \$147. Shorn lambs sold to \$145 and averaged \$131.50.



#### SHEEP

Rams sold to \$90 for 46 Merino rams sold by Elders on account Shalimar Park Merino Stud, Walcha. Dorper lambs sold to \$152 and Dorper ewes and lambs sold by DCM on account Hadley made \$140.

Ewes sold to \$120 and averaged \$76; wethers sold to \$124 and averaged \$108 with 393 sold; rams averaged \$70 with 93 sold; and mixed sheep sold to \$115 and averaged \$93.50 with 157 sold.
