



### From the sheepyards

Numbers were up this week with a yarding of just under 4500 head.

#### Lambs

The top price for lambs was \$152 for 45 2<sup>nd</sup> x lambs sold by DCM on account Tony & Kathy McCulloch, Garoo. Other highlights included pen 030 (pictured top left) sold by PPA for \$149. 2129 lambs were sold for an average of \$110 with another 482 shorn lambs topping at \$150 for M & J Fauchon and averaging \$131/head.



#### Suckers

Top price in the suckers was \$145 going to Charlie Hart for 65 head. The average was \$128/head with 291 sold.

#### Ewes

Top price in the ewes was \$147 for 100 x 2.5 year old ewes sold by Landmark on account Kelso Park for \$147 (pictured middle left). Other highlights included \$108 for 58 yellow (2013) and purple tag (2012) Dorpers (pen 191 pictured bottom left) sold by Elders on account Weroona Partnership, Tamworth. They were purchased by Simon Shannon, Gunnedah. The average price for ewes was \$73 with 712 sold.



#### Wethers

Wethers sold to \$86 (average \$73), hoggets sold to \$85 (average \$62), rams to \$96 (average \$37) and mixed sheep to \$86 (average \$70).
